EBC Members' Meeting



At our Deacons meeting on 10th May, the Diaconate agreed to change the 2 metre rule for our church services to 1 metre, with masks being worn as mitigation, this allows extra seating so there is no need to book in advance. Ventilation is increased so windows will remain open during the service. All our Covid-19 protocols remain in place – that means currently socialising is permissible with groups of up to 30 meeting outside and groups of six inside also allowed. Let's be persistent in our prayers. Pray hard and long. Pray for your brothers and sisters. Keep your eyes open. Keep each other's spirits up so that no one falls behind or drops out.

(Ephesians 6; verse 18-The Message).

In these times of uncertainty, continue to recognise that God is central, that true stability can only be found in Him, and pray that we be given the eye of faith that sees beyond uncertainties to the certainties: the things hoped for and the things unseen (Hebrews 11;verse 1).

The Persecuted Church. Burkina Faso is a country with a population of over 20 million, which has around 60% Muslims, 30% Christians, and 10% followers of traditional African religions. Until a few years ago, the various religions lived in peace together, despite political instability and military coups. The rise of extremist Islam has caused devastation, destroyed agriculture and displaced more than one million people, with many Christians being attacked and killed. Pray for the protection of Christians facing jihadist attacks. Ask that the extremists will turn away from violence. Pray that Christians' faith will remain steadfast, the needs of the displaced will be met, and that the bereaved will know God's comfort.

The World. Continue to pray that after the G7 Summit, that they and other countries in the world will increasingly work together to improve life for everyone in our world.

Landlords rights to evict tenants. Continue to pray that, with rules having changed from 1st June and with an estimated approaching half a million facing eviction by the autumn, that councils and other bodies will be able to meet the challenge. Pray also for landlords who may face expensive legal costs for no fault of their own.

Covid 19. Give thanks that, despite planned easing of restrictions being put back to 19th July, many people are still able to do more. Pray that people will be sensible in what they do, and that the present high level of infections will not lead to the NHS being overwhelmed. In other countries, pray that governments and health services will work together to improve their situations.

In EBC, give thanks for currently still being able to move towards reopening more activities, as well as developing new ministries. Pray for the health and circumstances of so many in our church fellowship, our families and friends. Pray for those who continue to be anxious or worried, and those who are wary of going out. May they have the comfort of friendship, and the deep peace of knowing they are loved.
