Pray that the new forming government in **Afghanistan** will be prepared to live peaceably, not just within their own borders, but with other countries.

Persecuted Christians. Pray about the persecution of over 260 million of our Christian brothers and sisters in countries around the world, that God will lift up Christians living under the constant threat of violence or injustice, simply because of their faith. The number of refugees arriving in flimsy boats on the shores of this country continues to set new records. Pray that our Government will act with wisdom and compassion in dealing with this situation. But also pray that God will move mightily, in addressing the wider problem of refugees in the world, with over 82 million people having been forcibly displaced in recent times. Our world. Pray about the problems of climate change, famine, poverty, war, and economic imbalance between countries-the gap between rich and poor.

Covid19. Pray for the over 200 countries in the world where Covid19 is being suffered by so many people. Pray that Governments and people of influence around the world will increasingly work together-to share their collective knowledge, experience and wealth so that everyone can benefit from the vaccines and protocols which are required to beat this disease. In this country, pray for wisdom from Government, and all of us, as we continue to live with this virus. Pray that some current shortages in the supply chain, especially of some essential foodstuffs and medical equipment (because of Covid illness and protocols, and reduced numbers of lorry drivers) will be eased.. Pray that as we enter Autumn, that Covid booster (and flu) vaccinations will be readily available.

**In EBC**. Continue to pray for those who are unwell, that they may rest in God's care as they receive treatment and support. As we start to be able to do more, thank God for enabling us to meet at our normal Sunday services, and to restart other things, our tea services, women's fellowship, Pinocchio's, Friday club and Energise. Thank God that the easing of restrictions is encouraging our regular, and some new, hirers to start their sessions. Thank God for Annette's baptism last Sunday, and the witness of her faith. We also thank God for his continued guidance in our search for a new minister."
