FOR OUR PRAYER TIMES

Let's be persistent in our prayers. Pray hard and long. Pray for your brothers and sisters. Keep your eyes open. Keep each other's spirits up so that no one falls behind or drops out (Ephesians 6:18-The Message)

Our prayers may be awkward. Our attempts may be feeble. But since the power of prayer is in the One who hears it and not in the one who says it, our prayers do make a difference (Max Lucado). **Our world.** Pray about the problems of climate change, famine,

war, and economic imbalance between countries. Pray especially at this time for successful diplomatic efforts to prevent possible invasion of Ukraine by Russia, and other places in the world where wars between and within countries are currently happening, often under the radar of regular news reporting.

Refugees. Pray for all refugees in the world today. Pray especially at this time for the thousands of refugees on the border between Belarus and Poland, seemingly being used as a political weapon. Pray also that countries around the world will develop ways to address this growing problem, created initially by wars, but what may in the future be created by climate change.

Persecuted church. Praise God for the hope we have, that all who are in Christ have already been made alive with Him and will one day be with him in glory. Pray for our brothers and sisters who today face harassment, discrimination, violence and persecution, that they will hold firm in the assurance of that living hope, and be sustained through the comfort of the Holy Spirit.

Pray for all the **countries in the world where Covid 19** is being suffered by so many people, including the effects of long Covid. Pray that Governments and people of influence will work increasingly together, so that everyone can benefit from the vaccines which are necessary to beat this disease. Pray especially at this time that necessary restrictions in this country and around the world are applied, and accepted, to curb additional infections in respect of the newly identified Covid variant, Omicron. Pray that families and friends will be able to meet at Christmas.

In this country, pray for those who are struggling. The effects of the pandemic has created and worsened many physical, emotional, mental, economic and social problems. Pray that God will move mightily in these situations, and bring hope and peace of mind. Pray that shortages in supply chains will be eased. Pray for the many families and individuals who are facing financial and accommodation difficulties at this time, and now face increased prices on food, fuel and other bills.

In EBC, continue to pray for David Wackett's funeral, which is on Monday. Continue to pray for those who are unwell, in body or in spirit, that they may rest in God's care as they receive treatment and support. Thank God that we are able to make more use of our building, especially during this period of Advent. Thank God for all the meetings, services and outreach events that are planned for the remainder of this year, and for the further plans that He has for our church. Thank Him for his continued guidance in our search for a new minister, which has led to the post being offered and accepted. Thank Him for our Minister, Jo Hellenbrand, and pray for her ordination service on Monday.
