**In EBC,** continue to pray for everyone in our fellowship, our families and friends, who are unwell at the moment, in body or spirit, that they may rest in God's care as they receive treatment and support. Pray for those who have been recently bereaved, that they may be comforted and have a deep sense of peace. We think of the impact of the Easter gift bags being delivered around our local care homes, the message of love this shows to residents and staff. Please pray for the start of the community café, that people will want to come along and find support and friendship. Pray for the leadership team as it meets on the 11th, welcoming Martin into ministry alongside Jo and looking forward to all that God has in store for us. **In all things; give thanks - as we are so very blessed.**
