FOR OUR PRAYER TIME\$

Let's be persistent in our prayers. Pray hard and long. Pray for your brothers and sisters. Keep your eyes open. Keep each other's spirits up so that no one falls behind or drops out.

(*Ephesians 6:18-The Message*) Our prayers may be awkward. Our attempts may be feeble. But since the power of prayer is in the One who hears it and not in the one who says it, our prayers do make a difference (Max Lucado)

This week, as well as your normal thanks and prayers for people and situations, we ask you to pray about these things.

Give thanks that the induction and ordination of our new minister Rev Martin Wright yesterday went well. **Give thanks for what God** has in store for our church as Martin now works in ministry alongside Rev Jo.

Pray about the continuing tragedy in respect of the

invasion of Ukraine. Pray that God will tear down evil schemes, and even now, when Russia are attacking many cities and other areas, especially in the south and east in Ukraine, that He will give wisdom to peacemakers seeking a less violent way; pray against fear -that He will rescue those who are vulnerable from the hands of their enemies; pray for the church in Ukraine-that He will give them courage in this crisis, and bind up broken hearts, and bring comfort to all who mourn; pray that Ukraine be delivered from evil-that He will have mercy and heal that country; pray that He will give that country peace, and the chance to develop as a nation that values truth, justice and freedom; pray for the safety and wellbeing of all the refugees (about 5.3 million who have left the country, and an estimated 7.7 million who have been displaced within the country), that they will find welcome and safe harbour.

Pray for all in the world who are being affected by the high increases in provision of energy and foodstuffs, that all of us, but especially those who are already living in poverty, will be able to cope.

Pray about the continuing increase in the numbers of **refugees** elsewhere in the world, with at the end of last year over 82 million people having fled from their countries.

Pray about the plight of God's **persecuted church** in countries around the world. Pray for Christians living under the constant threat of violence or injustice simply because of their faith. Pray also for all Christian refugees, that He will be their refuge and a strong tower, and that they will know His comfort and peace.

Pray for the many in **our fellowship** who have been, or continue to be, quite unwell. Lift up these, our brothers and sisters, up in prayer for God to comfort, strengthen and heal. **Thank the Lord** for the provision of health and support available to us all, and give compassion and sustenance to all those working to enable this. For those who are feeling anxious, lonely or sad at this time, may the peace that comes from resting in God's presence be experienced. **Thank God** for all the services and other events we are able to have

in our church, and thank Him for the further plans that He has for His church in Eastwood.
