FOR OUR PRAYER TIMES

Let's be persistent in our prayers. Pray hard and long. Pray for your brothers and sisters. Keep your eyes open. Keep each other's spirits up so that no one falls behind or drops out. (*Ephesians 6:18-The Message*)

Our prayers may be awkward, our attempts may be feeble but, since the power of prayer is in the One who hears it and not in the one who says it, our prayers do make a difference (Max Lucado).

As well as your normal thanks and prayers for people and situations, we ask you to pray about these matters.: **Ukraine**. Pray for the continuing tragedy of the war in that country and for all countries in the world where war is affecting the lives of so many. Pray that we do not become desensitised to the news of wars and ask God for guidance of what we can do to assist those in need. **Persecuted Church**. Pray that God will be close to all who are despised and rejected by their society because they trust Him as their Saviour. Pray that they will be encouraged by remembering that He also bore disgrace while He lived on earth, that He understands their hurt and was Himself a refugee, fleeing from His own homeland. **In this**

country and around the world, pray for those who are struggling with many physical, emotional, mental, economic and social problems. Pray that God will move mightily in these situations and bring hope and peace of mind. Pray for the many families and individuals who are facing financial and accommodation difficulties at this time, and are suffering from increased prices on food, fuel and other bills. Pray about the continuing problems relating to Covid 19, that we will all continue to be careful as we now live with the disease around us, and that vaccinations will continue to be made available to limit the spread of the disease and the severity of it, including the effects of long Covid. In EBC, continue to pray for those who are unwell, in body or spirit that they may rest in God's care as they receive treatment and support. Thank God for the many answers to prayer we have and thank Him for all the services and other events we are able to have in our church, including today's celebrations and continue to thank Him for the further plans He has for our church in Eastwood.
